Financial Administrator's Message

FAITH – The Best and Safest Course

To begin, I must put forward a disclaimer that I Am Not At All A Philosophical Person. The little knowledge I happen to have gathered from my personal experience is all I can sum up for this month's theme – "Be A Giver Of Faith". Faith emerges in two ways. It is either given immediately or must be built up over time. People who are natural Faith givers tend to be slightly more secure and less cautious based on their upbringing. This type of upfront Faith is either then validated or gets eroded over time.

Children, whenever something works in our favour, we claim that "we were right to Faith". If the thing doesn't work and Faith was eroded, then the Faith giver ends up disappointed with the other person.

If you are not a natural 'Faith giver' then you are probably a 'Faith earner'. This means you do not immediately Faith others. For you, Faith must be earned and accumulated over time. Faith earners tend to be more cautious. Their start point is wariness and they don't naturally Faith until the other person has proven themselves worthy of that Faith. Once Faith is earned, they can be loyal lifers.

Now.... ask yourselves, Are you a Faith giver or a Faith earner?

If you are a 9th or 10th std student, you definitely have read the story "My Greatest Olympic Prize" in your English class. Right?

An apt example to show how an unknown person (fellow sportsman Luz Long from Germany) instilled Jesse Owens' faith in himself which ultimately made him win 4 Gold Medals in the 1936 Olympics in Berlin.

This is Building, or indeed rebuilding. Faith for both Faith earners and Faith givers require us to ensure the four key elements of Faith are present. So, if you want to increase the level of Faith you need to focus on improving one or all of these elements:

1. Personal connection
2. Understand motives
3. Consistent delivery
4. Working style

I hope this did not sound like a lecture. I am sure, there are certain Christites who will understand the message I have put forth.





Harivansh Rai Bachchan



(27 November 1907 - 18 January 2003) was an Indian poet of the Nayi Kavita literary movement (romantic upsurge) of early 20th century Hindi literature. He was also a poet of the Hindi Kavi Sammelan. He is best known for his early work Madhushala. He is also the husband of social activist, Teji Bachchan, father of Amitabh Bachchan and grandfather of Abhishek Bachchan. In 1976, he received the Padma Bhushan for his service to Hindi literature. Bachchan was fluent in several Hindi languages (Hindustani, Awadhi). He incorporated a broadly Hindustani vocabulary, written in Devanagari script. While he could not read Persian script, he was influenced by Persian and Urdu poetry, particularly Omar Khayyam.

Located in northeast India, Meghalaya, also known as the Abode of Clouds, falls in one of the richest biodiversity areas in the world. The famed monsoons, the rich traditional festivals, and the dramatic terrain are just some of the many things this state is famous for. Whether you are looking for an adventure to give you an adrenaline high or a tranquil spot to recharge yourself, Meghalaya has plenty to offer.

The unforgettable landscapes of Meghalaya will stay in your heart, long after your journey is over. The table-top heights of Sohra (Cherrapunjee) are brimful with waterfalls, streams, and forest trails. Gaze at the Bangladeshi plains from the many vantage points on the state's southern ridges. The outskirts of Shillong and the high plateau around Myllem and Smit offer postcard-perfect representations of the simple life – complete with pastel green meadows, tall pine groves, crisp cool air, and quiet villages with quaint cottages and wooden fences spread across the countryside.

Further west, the Garo Hills burst into all the shades of green that you can think of. It is a region where you can travel on winding roads that pass through undisturbed forests where pachyderms and predators

still rule and discover rarely-breached ecosystems. Meghalaya's largely agrarian society has also contributed to this vibrant mosaic. Paddy fields neatly carved out of the hills and betel plantations that blend into the forest are just some examples you will come across. On the eastern part of the state, the Jaintia Hills offer more even enchanting views – a mix of heady cliffs, river-crossed tableland, rapids and waterfalls, and primeval forests that still remain unexplored in places.

Meghalaya is inhabited by many distinct tribes, the most prominent being the Khasis, the Garos, and the Pnars. Other tribes include the Hajongs, the Karbis, and the Koch. The tribes are further distinguished into sub-tribes and clans – represented in different dialects, diets, and clothing. There are many residents of the state whose previous generations have migrated from nearby and distant regions, especially in the capital Shillong – adding a cosmopolitan charm to the town.

A visit to Meghalaya will be incomplete without some cultural experiences. The best time to observe traditional practices and imagery is during the main festivals. Shad Suk Mynsiem is a major event in the Khasi calendar, celebrated in the month of April as a showing of gratitude to nature and to celebrate the harvest and the sowing of new seeds. Highlights include a dance where the participants are dressed in the rich traditional attire, laden with silk, gold, coral, and more.

Wangala is a harvest festival celebrated in the months between September and December across the Garo Hills. It is a great time to experience the old traditions of Meghalaya's western-most tribe and indulge in the unique cuisine of the place.


Shillong


Nongriat Root Bridges
