My dear Christites,

You have very truly remarked that if we are to reach real peace in this world and if we are to carry on a real war against war, we shall have to begin with children and if they will grow up in their natural innocence, we won't have the struggle, we won't have to pass fruitless idle resolutions, but we shall go from love to love and peace to peace, until at last all the corners of the world are covered with that peace and love for which, consciously or unconsciously, the whole world is hungering. - Mahatma Gandhi. Most people in our world don't understand peace as a positive concept. All they know is the negative aspect of peace, which is merely the absence of trouble. Peace is the opposite of running around in the midst of

constant anxieties. The Chol Indians of Mexico define peace as "a quiet heart." Those may be beautiful ways to put it, but they still seem to leave us with only the negative idea that peace is the absence of trouble. Teach your kids to be giver of peace. Let your child establish friendly relations with neighbours. Remember, it is

across the fence that quarrels often begin. Teach them to be patient if there are any misgivings with neighbours. Patience and peace go hand-in-hand. Whenever they have a problem with someone such as being unable to see eyeto-eye with that person on a particular issue, having a dispute over who has ownership rights over an object, or a simple disagreement, teach him to stay calm, analyse the situation, reflect on his actions and then resolve the issue. Encourage your children to set aside some 'quiet time' for themselves every day. Be a good example. Don't argue with anybody in front of children. Speak respectfully about other people. Don't gossip. Show kindness. It can be easy to forget that children are watching your every move, and learn more from what you do than what you say.

If we are to teach real peace in the world we shall have to begin with children. In this new century, we must start from the understanding that peace belongs not only to states or peoples, but to each and every member of the communities. Peace must be made real and tangible in the daily existence of every individual in need. Peace must be sought, above all, because it is the condition for every member of the human family to live a life of dignity and security.


write a journal, or seek a psychologist....






























ESPERANZA – THE GALLANT
