ART FROM WASTE (AFW)

Instructions:

ELOCUTION (EC)

Instructions:

- ➤ Language for Elocution must be English.
- Each candidate will be allotted 2 minutes.
- ➤ The participant should be in regular school uniform with blazer.
- > Speaker should memorize the speech & should not read out the speech from any paper notes or clue card
- ➤ No editing should be done after recording.
- ➤ If any editing in the video is recognised, the entry will be disqualified.

- > The late entries will not be entertained.
- > The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding

SOLO SONG (SS)

Instructions

- ➤ Any patriotic song
- > Songs can be of any language.

- ➤ The whole song should be recorded live. No editing should be done after recording.
