Instructions:

- No editing should be done after recording.

- The video recording should be clear and audible.
- The late entries will not be entertained.
- The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

Event : TONGUE TWISTER

Tongue twisters are a great way to practice and improve pronunciation and fluency in any language.

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. The competition is open to students of class 7.
2. Participants are given a tongue twister to say.
3. Time limit is 30 seconds.
4. Participant must say the given tongue twister **Loudly**, **Clearly** and **Faster**.
5. Participant must say the tongue twister as many times as possible within 30 seconds without making a mistake or giving a pause.
6. If a participant mispronounces the word, or tumbles or gives a pause while saying aloud such participant will be disqualified.

REGISTRATION PROCESS:-

1. Registration has to be done by the participant. Upon registering a unique id will be provided from the school.
2. Video editing is strictly prohibited and will be disqualified.
3. Active participation of the students is expected.

JUDGEMENT CRITERIA:-

Judgement and evaluation will be done based on the following criteria.

- Speed.
- Clarity of recitation.
- Audible.
- Maximum number of repetition.
- Over all presentation.
